Introduction

When you browse our website (https://aduvieportal.org), we use cookies and similar technologies to provide a secure and seamless experience. This policy explains in clear terms what these technologies are, how Aduvie International School uses them, and your rights to control them, in accordance with the Nigeria Data Protection Act (NDPA) 2023.

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device (computer, tablet, or mobile) when you visit our website. They allow the website to recognize your device and remember your actions and preferences over time.

We use the following types of cookies:

- **Session Cookies:** Temporary cookies that expire when you close your browser. They are essential for navigating the website during a single visit.
- **Persistent Cookies:** These remain on your device between browser sessions and allow us to remember your preferences or actions across our site.
- First-Party Cookies: Set directly by Aduvie International School on your device.
- **Third-Party Cookies:** Set by a third party (e.g., Google, YouTube) through our site for analytics and embedded content.

How We Use Cookies & Your Choices

We use cookies for the following specific purposes, which are categorized by their function and legal basis under the NDPA.

Type of Cookie	Purpose & Description	Legal Basis	How to Control
Strictly Necessary	These are essential for the website to function and cannot be switched off. They are usually set in response to your actions, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or filling in forms.	Legitimate Interest (NDPA S.25) - Necessary for the website to provide the core service you request.	These cookies cannot be refused. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will then not work.
Analytics / Performance	These allow us to count visits and traffic sources (e.g., using Google Analytics) so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us know which pages are the most and least popular. If you do not allow these cookies,	Consent (NDPA S.26)	You can give or withdraw your consent for these cookies via our cookie preference banner when you first visit our site, or at any time by clicking the "Cookie Preferences"

Functional / Preference	These enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization, such as remembering your language preference. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our pages. Targeting / Marketing	These are set by third-party services embedded on our site, such as YouTube. They may be used to track your activity across different websites and build a profile of your interests to show you relevant advertising.	Consent (NDPA S.26)	You can give or withdraw your consent for these cookies via our cookie preference banner. Blocking them may result in seeing non-personalized ads.
